



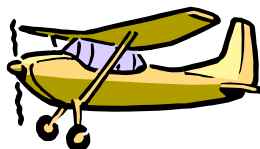

It's pretty crazy as there is so much to do that you don't know where to start. Our bedroom and living room are full of Rubbermaid containers.

We are set to leave July 7th for Redlands, California for two weeks of training and from there fly to Papua. Right now our Visa applications are in Jakarta and we hope that they will be approved before the end of

July, otherwise we will need to spend a little more time in California.... That would be a tough pill to swallow....

We know that there will be a lot more bugs in Papua than we are used to. So to prepare the kids a little we purchased a bunch of large plastic bugs at the dollar store and spread them around the house.
